



Sambhramaa 5.0 General Guidelines

1. **Discipline Declaration:** All students are required to complete and submit the Discipline Declaration in digital format before arriving at the ISAB Greater Noida Campus. This is essential to ensure adherence to campus discipline.
2. **Accommodation:** Stay will be available from **8:00 AM on 13th December 2024 to 4:00 PM on 14th December 2024**.
3. **Event Guidelines:** All event guidelines and deadlines must be strictly adhered to by participants.
4. **Personal Items:** Students must bring their blankets and bedsheets for hygiene purposes.
5. **Contact Information:** Ensure that the contact details provided during registration are correct, as they will be used for future communication.
6. **Identity Proof:** Each participant must carry a valid identity proof.
7. **Awards Notification:** Top participants will be shortlisted, and the top 3 will be invited to receive awards. Notifications will be emailed and announced on our **LinkedIn** and **Instagram** pages.
8. **Team Structure:** No changes to the team structure are allowed once registration is complete.
9. **Minimum Participation:** If there are fewer than 10 entries (teams) for any event, then in such case the event will be terminated
10. **Stay and Travel Reimbursement:** Teams participating in the final rounds at ISAB will be provided accommodation as per institutional norms. Travel expenses will be reimbursed up to **₹1,000 per participant**, upon submission of bills.
11. **Professor/Student In-Charge:** One professor or student in-charge from each participating college is welcome to accompany their teams to ISAB to encourage and motivate them.
12. **Accommodation for Professors/Student In-Charge:** Lodging for professors or student in-charges will be provided by ISAB as per institutional guidelines. Travel expenses will be reimbursed up to **₹2,000 per professor**, upon submission of bills.
